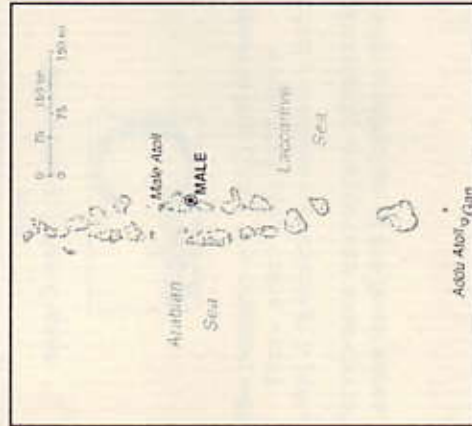

MALDIVIAN CIVILIZATION

The Republic of Maldives is an archipelago consisting of twenty-six coral atolls, in the northern Indian Ocean. The twenty-six coral atolls contain 1,190 very small islands of which 198 are inhabited. The climate is warm and tropical. Seasonal changes are determined by the two early monsoons. The season of the northeast monsoon is characterized by dry, mild winds and generally extends from December to April. The southwest monsoon, although irregular, extends from May until August and brings heavy rains and wind. The northern atolls are drier, while the southern atolls are wetter. The humidity is fairly high throughout the year.

Dhivehi, which spoken in all parts of the country, is not spoken in any other part of the world. It is considered an Indo-European language related to Sinhala, the language spoken in Sri Lanka. The alphabets and writing system are similar to Arabic. English is the second language and is widely used in commerce and in many government schools

Maldivian culture can be said to be a blend of the many cultures brought by the sea farers who settled in Maldives. This confluence of culture was further influenced by the British and the Portuguese during their rule. The Islamic religion has contributed to the further evolution of the culture of Maldives
